

Silver City Squares Youth Present to you a MS square dance that you can be part of and have a ball doing it. This dance is for dancers who have completed mainstream lessons so don't think you can't do it.

The dance will be held at the Maplewood Grange on October 1, 2016. The dance will consist of a work shop from 4 to 6:15pm a potluck dinner break to 7:30 with the dance starting at 7:30. (Cuers from the floor) The dance will be based on the work shop. There will be no singing calls and no Allemande Left, you will just appear at home, magically of course.

The work shop will consist of the following:

- You will learn square discipline and why it is so important in doing the calls at any level and at any dance you attend to keep from crashing your square.
- You will learn leaders and trailers, centers and ends, and why it is so important to really know them, i.e.: know who you are in a square. This will be a work shop unlike any you have ever been in before, but you will have fun in it
- You will learn the definitions to the calls we will be using based mainly on leaders and trailers, centers and ends. You will not believe what Don can do with: walk and dodge, zoom, trade by, slide through, grand square, swing thru, spin the top, square thru, circulates, etc but you will have fun doing them. At the level Don calls at, the calls have to be legal or the dancers will call him on it.

Your caller will be Don Benson; he is a C2 caller since 1985 and has worked with the Silver City Squares kids for the last 5 years. This last year they missed a tie for 1st place by ½ of a point out of around 1300 points and the previous year by 1 point.

Always remember this no matter how good the material is, if the dancer can't dance it, it's worthless. MS at a regular MS dance learn a few simple rules, kick up your heels and have a good time and that is all it should be.

This is not a regular dance. That is why you need to attend the work shop.

Go to youtube.com and type it PNTSDF mystery. There are several levels that the kids compete in MS and Plus levels.
