CAMP KOINONIA RULES

2. No alcohol, drugs, firearms or fireworks.
3. No smoking on site.
4. Campfires are allowed only in designated pits.
5. Notify the Camp Manager immediately if damage occurs to camp property.
6. Children must be supervised at all times, including in the Game Room. Adults are responsible for making sure children use the camp facilities appropriately. Also, the camp is located in a forested area next to a river. Wild animals and harmful plants are a natural occurrence, so close supervision is necessary for children's protection.
7. Please leave the camp in the same condition it was in when you arrived.
8. The Camp Manager may add to this list at any time and will notify the group's contact person if needed.
