QUESTION: What's choreographed ballroom dancing? **ANSWER:** This is ballroom dancing to traditional rhythms and music with live verbal cuing that announces a prescribed sequence of figures (the dance choreography) with appropriate lead time for the music. This frees the man from primary responsibility for planning dance figures and leading his partner in real time. Choreographed ballroom dancing involves learning dance-figure terminology, footwork, and body movement for each rhythm. Once dance figures are learned for a given rhythm, they can be executed, as cued, to any music in that rhythm. There is no need to memorize dances.
